Globalism's Tree of Death

Gary Kah's book reveals carefully laid foundations upon which the Western world's spiritual morass now rests: Psychology, hope in a 'super-humanity'; broad acceptance of eastern beliefs; a universal Christ-consciousness.

At 199 pages and medium print it is light enough to make for an easy read. Although written nearly twenty years ago, like the plan of the Guiding Spirits, the material is unchanging.

The 'Aquarian Age', 'Omega Point', 'Return to Atlantis', or 'New World Order' are synonyms for what is planned by 'the Hierarchy'. This 'Hierarchy' is simply Satan and his fallen angels working through deceived victims.

These victims, or New Age icons include Pope John Paul II, Pierre Teilhard de Chardin (Jesuit Priest), Helena Petrovna Blavatsky (founder of Theosophy), Annie Besant, Alice Bailey, Barbara Marx Hubbard, and Carl Jung (co-founder of modern psychology).

These were used in different areas of endeavour by personal 'spirit guides' (familiar spirits) which took names like Master Morya, Djwhal Khul, Asher, Koot Hoomi, and Seth. They seem to have a proclivity for dry, remote places (e.g. Tibet):

“When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through **dry places**, seeking rest, and findeth none.” (Luke 11.43)

The plan to 'externalise' the Hierarchy has three phases: Preparatory (1875-1890), Intermediate (1919-1949) and Revelatory (1975-). Organisations

doing the work include Lucifer Publishing Company/Lucis Trust (a U.N affiliate), Theosophical Society, the Vatican, and the World Council of Churches. Even Greenpeace is on the fringe.

Most confronting are the clear themes in the 'Ascended Masters' (familiar spirit's) writings:

*Evolution is true.

*Every person has a higher self they can 'tap into'.

*There is no God, hell, no saviour and you can save yourself.

*Spiritual energies are awaiting release via coordinated, world-wide invocations from the 'New Group' of 'World Servers'. They employ prayer 'Triangles' using the 'Great Invocation'.

*A negative group [Bible-believing Christians] is blocking the transition from the 'Piscean' to the 'Aquarian' age. Like a cancer they need to be excised.

*The new world can only be built by destroying the old. Men like Mussolini, Franco, Hitler and Stalin were helpers in this endeavour, being driven by the 'Shamballa' force.

Unfortunately the author seems unaware of the nefarious nature of the NIV 'bible' he quotes many times (the 'International' should have been a give away). Hebrews 9.10 in the NIV has: "...external regulations applying until the time of the new order."

Deceptive doctrines of the New Age should be plain to Christians and this knowledge can be used to re-double efforts reaching the lost.

Contrary to promises of 'healing' and 'building a better world', out workings of the 'Hierarchy's' 'Ageless Wisdom' so far have been two world wars, ongoing threat of nuclear war, terrorism, near economic collapse and moral anarchy:

“Every tree that bringeth forth not good fruit is hewn down, and cast into

the fire. Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.” Matthew 7.20

Introduction (pp. 7-10)

UN empowerment, international trade efforts and a proposed world-tax are all physical signs the world is headed for Global Governance.

The spiritual element is perhaps more important and is to be focused on.

Laying the Foundations for Omega Point (pp. 11-74)

The only being capable of orchestrating the global spiritual development of mankind over the past hundred years in particular is Lucifer, the goal being an 'Omega Point'. Interestingly, Omega brain waves are completely flat so this event is akin to fatal delusion on a grand scale.

Many powerful occult groups were seeded in the 1800s: Joseph Smith's Mormonism (1830); Mary Baker Eddy's Christian Science (1860s); Helena P. Blavatsky's Theosophical Society (1875); Charles Taze Russell's Jehovah Witnesses (1879); Charles and Myrtle Fillmore's Unity Church (1886).

On Blavatsky, she was born 12/8/1831 in Russia. She received guidance from a spirit master; a Hindu in a white turban that encouraged her at age twenty to leave England for India to organise the Theosophical Society.

A good summary of her character: “I wouldn't be a slave to God Himself, let alone any man...Woman finds her happiness in the acquisition of supernatural powers. Love is but a vile dream, a nightmare.”

Her two major works were *Isis Unveiled* and *The Secret Doctrine*. In the former are doctrines:

*An equally pious man, rather than dying of old age, if sacrificed in like manner as Jesus could have created as successful a religion as Christianity.

*Humanity is an evolutionary expression of the Supreme Being.

In *The Secret Doctrine*, Lucifer is praised as proud enough to believe himself God, brave enough to buy independence with eternal suffering and strong enough to reign in darkness. Further, he is our Mind, Tempter, Redeemer and Saviour. Aliases include Lord of Phosphorous, Light-Bearer, and the Fiery Dragon.

Blavatsky also called for assassination of national leaders to bring about world revolution.

Hitler was a disciple, keeping a copy of *The Secret Doctrine* by his bedside. Nazis called the 'Masters' *Ubermenschen*, and they were thought to reside in places like the Gobi desert, Western China and the Himalayas¹. Hitler imported Tibetans so by 1941 one thousand were living in Berlin.

Blavatsky died aged sixty, alone and estranged.

Annie Besant took over the Society in 1891 when she was illuminated by Tibetan 'Master Morya'.

Alice Bailey was the most prominent worker of the New Age, guided by a Tibetan Djwhal Khul. She was born 6/6/1880 in Manchester, England and "served" the Lord without ever really "knowing" Him. Through life events she eventually began reading *The Secret Doctrine* which led her to uncover 'Christ' and 'the planetary Hierarchy'².

Bailey was a female mason, established Lucifer Publishing Company, World Goodwill, Triangles, the Arcane School and the New Group of World Servers. She died 15/12/1949, age 69.

There is an earthly spiritual 'Hierarchy' which is made up of those who have achieved the goal of 'self-mastery'. They are also called 'Custodians of the Plan', 'Adepts' and 'Hierarchy of Initiates'. At the top are the 'Ascended Masters', those who have gone through numerous cycles of reincarnation. Beliefs vary as to whether Masters are physically on earth, or live on a spiritual plane.

Masters can be contacted telepathically through TM³.

The timeline to 'externalise' the Hierarchy has three phases: Preparatory (1875-1890) [from Blavatsky], Intermediate (1919-1949) [from Bailey], and Revelatory (1975-) [mass media]. This will end with a 'Return to Atlantis', return seeing as it was destroyed by the Great Flood. Blavatsky in *The Secret Doctrine* puts it as:

“after the war between the Lords of the Shining Countenance and Lords of the Dark Face.”

Here, those of the 'Shining Countenance' are really devils, those of the 'Dark Face' angels.

On Freemasonry, Albert Pike described it as the 'custodian' of occult secrets of what happened after the flood with Nimrod and the Tower of Babel.

*In *Cocoon* (1995), a race of light beings from sunken Atlantis return with promise of immortality to those who follow them.

Modern media align with these ideas:

**E.T.* () is centered on a likeable reptilian with supernatural power.

**Star Wars* has its god-like but impersonal 'force' to harness.

**The Never Ending Story* (1) teaches children they can create their own reality.

The strategy of the Hierarchy is diabolical. From Bailey:

*They work quietly and smoothly [Gn 3.1].

*Hegelian dialectic and six-step attitudinal change plan⁴ techniques are used. The once radical becomes reasonable and natural [Rm 1.21].

*They ignore time, but only to a limit [Mt 8.29]. This means they are extremely opportunistic [Jb 1.12].

*Work remotely.

Vessels of the Hierarchy do not claim demonic possession, rather communing with their 'higher self'⁵.

New Age doctrine is built upon evolution, reincarnation, astrology and meditation, each having a true counterpart in the Christian faith (creation, resurrection, Holy Spirit, thanksgiving). There is Lucis Trust's 'Great Invocation'.

Some specific teachings of Djwhal Khul, as channelled by Bailey:

*The Christ work for all men, irrespective of their faith.

*The Christ will *not* take a Jewish body as he did before.

*The Jews represent...materialism, cruelty and a spiritual conservatism.

*The Founder of the Christian faith seeks to bring a new Gospel⁶.

*The Zionists in Palestine...run counter to all the plans of the spiritual Hierarchy.

*The energy of destruction has its side of beauty.

*Pain has always been the purifying agent, employed by the Lords of Destiny, to bring about liberation⁷.

*The World War (II) was a major surgical operation. Another surgical operation may be necessary (!).

*The Hierarchy is struggling hard with the 'forces of evil'.

*Napoleon, Bismark, Hitler, Lenin, Stalin and Franco were expressions of the Shamballa force and creators of the new order, the destroyers of what must be destroyed.

*Recognition of successful work of the NGWS will be found in a symbol projected by the

Hierarchy, a mark of the saviour⁸.

*There is no angry God, no hell, no vicarious atonement and Jehovah is not God.

*The orthodox Christian will find it increasingly difficult to induce the 'intelligent masses' to accept the 'feeble' Christ.

Presenting the Occult as Science (pp. 75-97)

The two most academic influencers in the New Age movement are said to be Carl Jung and Pierre Teilhard de Chardin.

Jung was born 26/7/1875 in Switzerland. He had an occult upbringing with visions of ghosts and was scared by a Jesuit priest in black on one occasion. He rejected the objectivism of Christianity in favour of personal experience. Later in life he became involved in Gnosticism, I Ching and Alchemy.

Jung and Sigmund Freud collaborated together for six years. Jung's doctrines include:

*The collective unconscious behind every individual, the 'psychic residue of human evolutionary development'.

*Inside the 'collective' common archetypes are found: 'god', the hero, birth, death, magic, the demon, and the earth mother.

*Dream interpretation is key in Jungian analysis.

Chardin was born 1/5/1881 in France. He was interested in geology from an early age and became a Jesuit. His theology was pantheism with everything conforming to evolution and he is the most widely read author in the New Age movement.

Disciples include former POTUS contender Mario Cuomo, Zbigniew Brzezinski, and long term UN official Robert Mueller.

He died 10/4/1955, age 73. There is now a Teilhard Centre for the Future of Man in London, and the Teilhard Foundation in Boulder, Colorado.

Teilhard's last words after momentarily regaining consciousness, “this time, I feel it's terrible.”

The Facade of Global Unity (pp. 98-138)

The key of worldly unity is providing a method which doesn't involve repentance and acknowledgement of the God of the Bible.

Joseph Randolph Price (d. 2014) created the Quartus Foundation in Austin, Texas to bring about the Omega Point of human evolution. Help came from his spirit guide Asher.

Price created World Healing Day (to be celebrated 31 Dec.), and inspired the Earth Summit (1992) and Parliament of World Religions Conference (1993). This is to counter negative thought patterns which can affect the entire planet. This is known as the 'hundredth monkey' concept, which states one monkey can transfer knowledge to another 98 on an island, then a single isolated monkey on another island somehow receives this knowledge by virtue of the fact he is a monkey.

Some of Price's teachings:

*“I am co-creator with God”.

*“I and the Father are One.”

*“I am the Christ of God.”

*“Let mankind be returned to godkind.”

* “Individuals with 'lower vibratory rates' will be removed 'within the next two decades [c2006].

*“The light shall spread to the island of darkness and it shall cease to exist.”

Another icon of New Age globalism is Barbara Marx Hubbard. In 1986 she led a delegation to Russia and found a kindred spirit in Moscow writer

Joseph Goldin. She claimed Dec 31, 1986 as a 'Planetary Pentecost' where millions could lift their own individual consciousness to attain a mass Christ-consciousness.

Hubbard's epiphany came after reading Chardin, also while on a sabbatical in 1980 near a monastery where she heard the voice of Jesus.

She also wrote a commentary on Revelation:

*The red-horse is the destruction during the birth process for those who refuse to be born into God-centered life.

*The elders have been waiting patiently before the 'quantum transformation'. They are the riders of the pale horse.

*One half of the world is to be destroyed, and of the remaining one-quarter are to be guides for the others who will be panicked and confused.

Other significant events include: Million Minutes of Peace; Peace the 21st; The First Earth Run; 1986 Vatican Interfaith Conference; The Harmonic Conference.

Deceptions of a Post-Christian Era (pp. 139-157)

Shirley MacLaine and her 1987 five hour *Out on a Limb* odyssey mass marketed reincarnation, channelling, Atlantis, aliens, yoga, meditation and astral projection to millions of viewers.

MacLaine was influenced by the Association for Research and Enlightenment (ARE), founded by Edgar Cayce, the 'Sleeping Prophet'. Cayce claimed to see spirit children at age seven, and without medical training gave 14,246 diagnoses one time aged twenty.

Reincarnation is growing ever popular with 23% of Americans subscribing to the belief (c1985).

Holistic health with its focus on strange energy (non-nuclear, gravitational, electromagnetic) is popular. There is 'chi' and the interplay of yin and yang across invisible meridians inside the body.

Iridology is akin to eye-reading.

Satan's power to perform miracles is often underestimated, and while many of them may be illusions, he does have real power. This ensnares the occult-healer in a pragmatic fashion, including Tarot, past-life regression, astrology, sensory deprivation, hypnosis, and altered states of consciousness.

Reincarnatinist Dick Sutphen in *What Is-New Age Activists* wrote: "...our momentum will become so great that the combined efforts of all antagonists can't stop us unless they do so politically."

Conclusion (pp. 158-174)

The New Age has brought chaos so far. At the edge in public relations are groups like Lucis Trust, Greenpeace, the Rainbow Coalition and the Theosophical Society. Close to the core is Freemasonry, in between are groups like the Club of Rome, Trilateral Commission and the Council on Foreign Relations.

Progression of the plan is evidenced by the openness of once tightly held occult secrets, in places like book stores and news agencies.
