## Fifteen Lies From 'Mary'



Since October, 2007, an organisation called Mary's Rosary Chain has published cards promoting a 13<sup>th</sup>C legend, that Mary (who died 1,200 years earlier!), made fifteen promises to 'Saint' Dominic and all rosary-prayers (those who repeat ten prayers called "decades" by counting beads).

The below promises also have the permission of Cardinal George Pell, imprimatur from the Archbishop of New York as well as the Bishop of Talattula (in ancient Tunisia) who lives in Sydney!

**I)** Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the rosary, shall receive signal graces.

"Thou shalt fear the Lord thy God, and <u>serve him</u>, and shalt swear by his name." **Deuteronomy 6.13, Authorized Version** 

**II)** I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the rosary.

Mary was never full of grace so has none to promise: "And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women." Luke 1.28

**III)** The rosary shall be a powerful armour against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat Heresies.

Christians are commanded put on the armour of *God*, not the rosary:

"Put on the whole armour <u>of God</u>, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil." **Ephesians 6.11** 

**IV)** It will cause good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God...

The blind beggar did not seek recourse to a rosary, but obtained mercy by direct appeal to Jesus:

"And he cried, saying, Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me." Luke 18.38

V) The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the rosary, shall not perish.

Recommending oneself to Mary doesn't save a soul, only belief in Jesus:

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth <u>in him</u> should not perish, but have everlasting life." **Ephesians 6.11** 

**VI)** Whoever shall recite the rosary, shall never be conquered by misfortune...and become worthy of eternal life.

No one can ever become worthy to receive eternal life:

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: <u>Not of works</u>, lest any man should boast. **Ephesians 2.8-9, AV** 

**VII)** Whoever shall have a true devotion for the rosary shall not die without the sacraments of the Church.

The sacraments of the Roman Catholic Church are useless in life and death:

Jesus saith unto him,  $\underline{I}$  am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 14.6, AV

VIII) Those who are faithful to recite the rosary...at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the saints in paradise.

No saint has any "merits", they only receive personal rewards by Jesus Christ at His judgment seat:

- "If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward." I Corinthians 3.14
- **IX)** I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the rosary.
- 'Purgatory' is a mythical place as after death the dead go to either heaven or hell:
- "And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence." Luke 16.26
- **X)** The faithful children of the rosary shall merit a high degree of glory in heaven.

God already pre-ordained levels of glory for saints apart from the rosary:

- "But to sit on my right hand and on my left hand is not mine to give; but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared." Mark 10.40
- XI) You shall obtain all you ask me by the recitation of the rosary.
- 'Mary' has nothing to give so knows she cannot deliver:
- "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down <u>from the Father</u> of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." James 1.17
- XII) All who propagate the holy rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.

Mary couldn't even supply enough wine at the wedding in Cana and had to rely on Jesus to make it; she has no power to help anyone:

"And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine." John 2.3

**XIII)** I have obtained mercy from my Divine Son that advocates of the rosary shall have for intercessors the entire celestial court...

The only intercessor for mankind that counts is Jesus Christ:

"For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;" I Timothy 2.15

XIV) All those who recite the rosary are...brothers and sisters of my only son Jesus Christ

All rosary-prayers must be *born again* to become children of God, otherwise they remain children of the devil:

"You are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do." John 8.44a

**XV)** Devotion of my rosary is a great sign of predestination:

"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof *are* the ways of death" **Proverbs 14.12**
