## Holy Bible (Authorized Version)

The only head is *Jesus Christ*. It is built on the revelation He is the Son of God. (Ephesians 5.23, Colossians 1.18, Matthew 16.16-18)

The title was invented, it's not in the Bible<sup>1</sup>. The Apostles were without hierarchy. (Luke 22.24-26, Galatians 2.11-14)

That is reserved for God *only*, attributing this to a man is blasphemy. (John 17.11, John 10:33)

The eternal Trinitarian God cannot have a mother (or father).<sup>2</sup> (Revelation 1.8, Psalm 93.2, Isaiah 41.4)

Jesus was Mary's *first* born. He had brothers and sisters, including the Apostle James. (Matthew 1.25, Psalm 69.8, Mark 6.3, Galatians 1.19)

Only the Lord Jesus Christ has that role. (I Timothy 2.5, Hebrews 9.15)

No, God identifies this false god as a detestable abomination of the heathen which the Israelites worshipped. (Jeremiah 7.18; 44.17-19)

No biblical or historical evidence exists, this is a bald proclamation some 1900 years later to justify her worship.<sup>3</sup> (Hebrews 9.27)

It's called necromancy which God condemns.<sup>4</sup> (Leviticus 20.6, Deuteronomy 18.11-12)

All Christians (i.e. born-again believers) are saints automatically!<sup>5</sup> (Philippians 4.21-22, I Corinthians 1.2)

God forbids both the fabrication of religious icons *and* bowing before them.<sup>5</sup> (Exodus 20.4-5, Deuteronomy 4.28, Acts 17.29)

Jesus forbade Christians calling anyone their (spiritual) father, seeing as God is their true father. (Matthew 23.9)

God *only* has this power which he doesn't share. (Mark 2.5-7, Luke 5.20-21, I John 1.9)

Only the work of God's only begotten Son at the cross is accepted, and cannot be added to. (Romans 3.28, Ephesians 2.8-9)

Christians have an iron-clad guarantee. (I John 5.13, John 10.27-29)

This was a money-making scheme created to keep people in fear and make Rome rich.<sup>5</sup> (Hebrews 9.27, John 5.29, Luke 16.23-26)

A false church responsible for the 'holy' murders of (mainly) Christians up until the last Inquisition ending 1834.<sup>7</sup> (Revelation 17.3-6, 18.24)

The Vatican City-State in Rome, resting upon seven mountains. (Revelation 17.9,18)

The devil of course, but his earthly agent is the anti-christ, the papacy. Each pope is a Vicar (substitute) of Christ on earth. (Revelation 13.18, II Thessalonians 2.4)

## Holy Bible (Authorized Version)

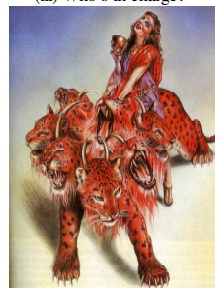
